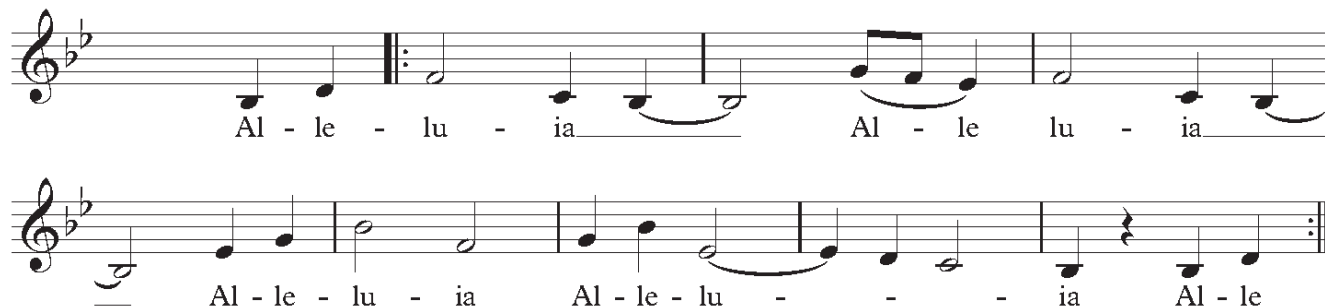

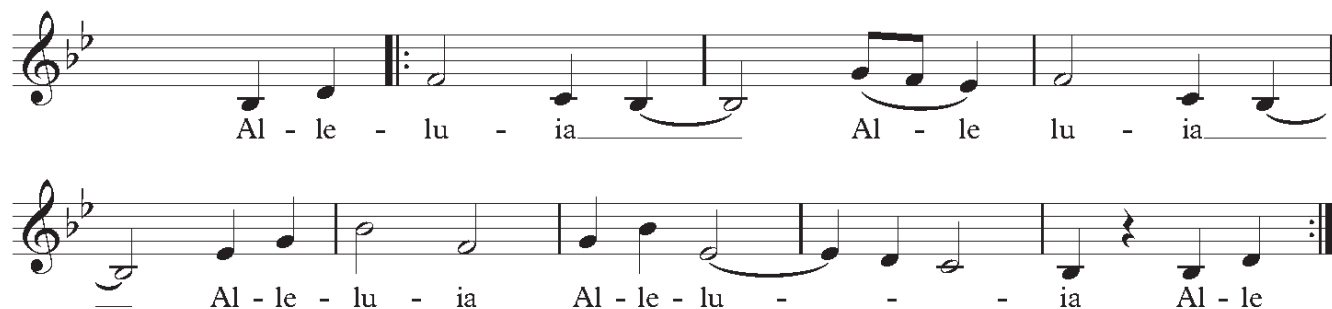
The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the 28th Chapter.


